## Pastor Rickie G. Rush - A Bridge to Peace - #5



When does a boy become a man? What is his official rite of passage? Men of all ages, oftentimes, choose destructive methods in their weak attempts to prove they are grown. My call and charge from God is to train men to fulfill their roles as strong Christian leaders who deeply impact their families, positively influence their marriages, and exhibit resilient leadership in their community. Satan is threatened when men become men of God. He doesn't mind if they become grown. If you call on the man inside of a man, he will come forth. I am charged with turning losers into leaders.

The IBOC Bridge to Peace has been realized through helping men turn their lives around and teaching them about becoming the men God intended them to be. In IBOC Men's Fellowship, men learn how to pursue a relationship with God (based upon

Proverbs 27:17). First, however, they have to know that you see them NOT as there are, but as they CAN be. Our men have learned they were created in God's own image, and that their character, conduct and conversation should reflect the Father in all aspects of their lives. They also learn the importance of prayer, God's system of generous giving, and the importance of treating pastors, persons in authority, spouses, relatives, neighbors and friends with genuine respect and love. Godly leaders can never cease in the raising of our boys to be men. As spiritual leaders of this nation, we must all become "lost-sons minded". This process, developing a whole man from a broken child, begins when men are valued, honored and given responsibility. The main piece in this process is shedding labels that people have put upon men, made possible only through the Word of God, unconditional love, a generous dose of forgiveness, and unadulterated support. God has called men to be tough foundations. We must REFUSE to sit idly by and let men die.

Why are we losing men in the areas of personal respect for those in authority, leadership in church, submission, and simple good manners? How can we create a bridge to peace? IBOC Men's Fellowship is designed to rebuild, restore and reconcile men who have suffered life's heartaches, struggles and setbacks. We, as religious leaders, must model and teach boys and men of all ages that the LOVE of and from God conquers all! LOVE and FORGIVENESS of others is how we will survive and thrive in this world. The bible gives us an explicit message of LOVE and COMPASSION in the story of the Good Samaritan. As men of God, let us forever remember that:

- Reflections of an Inner City Male (Dallas ISD, 2010)
- Project MALE: Men of Distinction (Cedar Valley Community College, 2014-15)
- P.O.T. Boys Conference (Parents of Teenage Boys, 2013)
- The publication of my book, Come Out Swinging: The Pendulum, has offered men understanding of how to make successful comebacks from difficult life setbacks. (2014)
